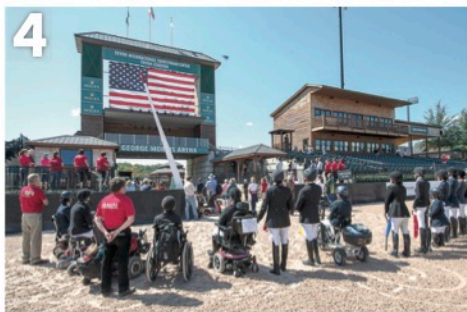


2017 CAPITAL CHALLENGE HORSE SHOW — UPPER MARLBORO, MARYLAND
