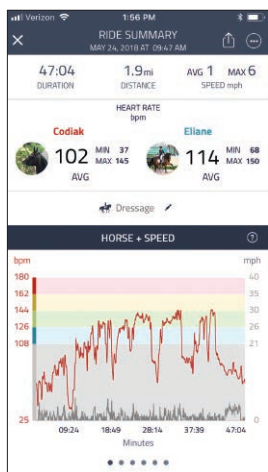

Essex Horse Trials water jump

The **Mars Essex Horse Trials** continued its successful revival following a 19-year absence with six divisions held each day at its second event in June. The \$20,000 Preliminary Essex headlined the Trials and was captured by Australia's **Ryan Wood** and **Ruby** who led the division from start to finish with clear rounds in both cross-country and show jumping to finish on their dressage score of 27.70. Spectators also enjoyed family-friendly activities including the **Tewksbury Foot Bassets** who ventured out of the arena allowing fans to get "up close and personal," which was extremely popular. Another crowd pleaser was the Classic Car Show featuring stunning vehicles from various decades. Proceeds from the event benefit the **Greater Newark LifeCamp** in nearby Pottersville, which provides an enriching day camp experience for approximately 300 Newark-area youths per day for six weeks during July and August.
