The clinic will feature a unique format, with Assistant Trainer Cody Wooten kicking things off by riding the horses on day one to better understand the needs of each individual rider and horse.

"Obviously you can't fix everything in a weekend, but I think this format is still going to help the riders tremendously," Caitlyn said of the clinic's structure. "Cody can communicate what each horse needs and I can translate that into actionable items for the riders to work on to strengthen the bond with the horse and to improve the relationship over time."

This clinic will be open to students of Old Seoul Equestrian only, but Caitlyn is available to teach clinics all throughout the Midwest and East Coast in the coming months. She welcomes students at all levels of riding, something she believes sets her apart as a clinician in the hunter/jumper world. 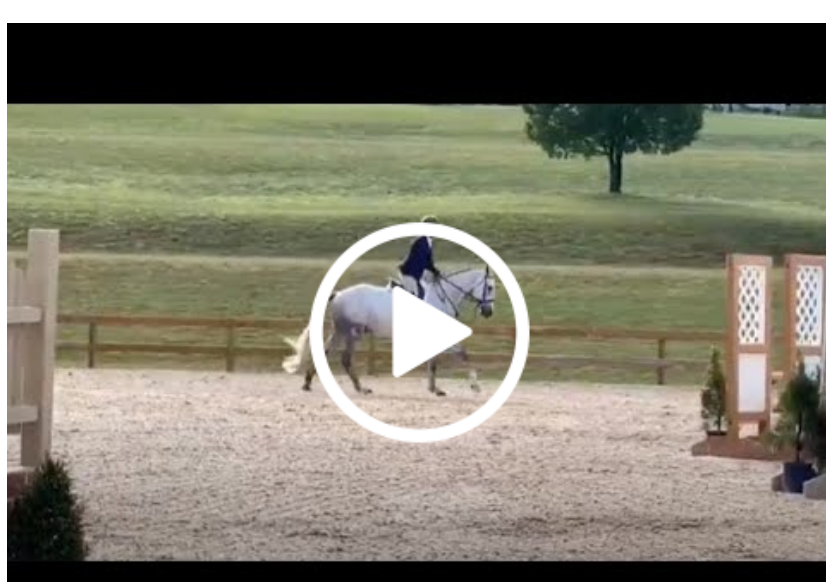
