Will Simpson and Chacco P Claim Victory in the \$75,000 **Coca-Cola Beverages Florida Grand Prix at WEC – Ocala**

Will Simpson (USA) piloted Chacco P to the top prize in the \$75,000 Coca-Cola Beverages Florida Grand Prix on Saturday, December 4, 2021, during the World Equestrian Center - Ocala Fall III Show. Simpson and the 12-year-old Mecklenburg gelding owned by Will Simpson Show Stables Inc., navigated the first round track, designed by Catsy Cruz (MEX), with ease to advance to the jump-off along with nine other competitors. The pair produced a quick jump-off time of 36.815 seconds to top the leaderboard.

Simpson was energized by the atmosphere at WEC. He said, "Tonight felt like it was big time with the lights and the crowd. Chacco P walked in the ring, took a look at the lights and I could feel that he was ready to go. He knew he better put on his best performance."

An additional \$5,000 was awarded to Morgan Ward (USA) and Morlynn Farm's Cesar De B'Neville, who jumped the fastest four-fault round in the \$75,000 Coca-Cola Beverages Florida Grand Prix, in a time of 77.135 seconds. Harold Chopping (CAN) and Geronimo SCF received the \$5,000 Luck of the Draw award.

"My plan for the handy was to just give him a confidence-building ride and do all the low options," explained Kellner. "I did end up going inside to the last in-and-out, and he was perfect. He is super athletic and super capable, so if you tell him he can do it, he will give you his all."

Megan Young piloted Comanche to the win in the \$10,000 WEC – Ocala 3' Hunter Derby.
