

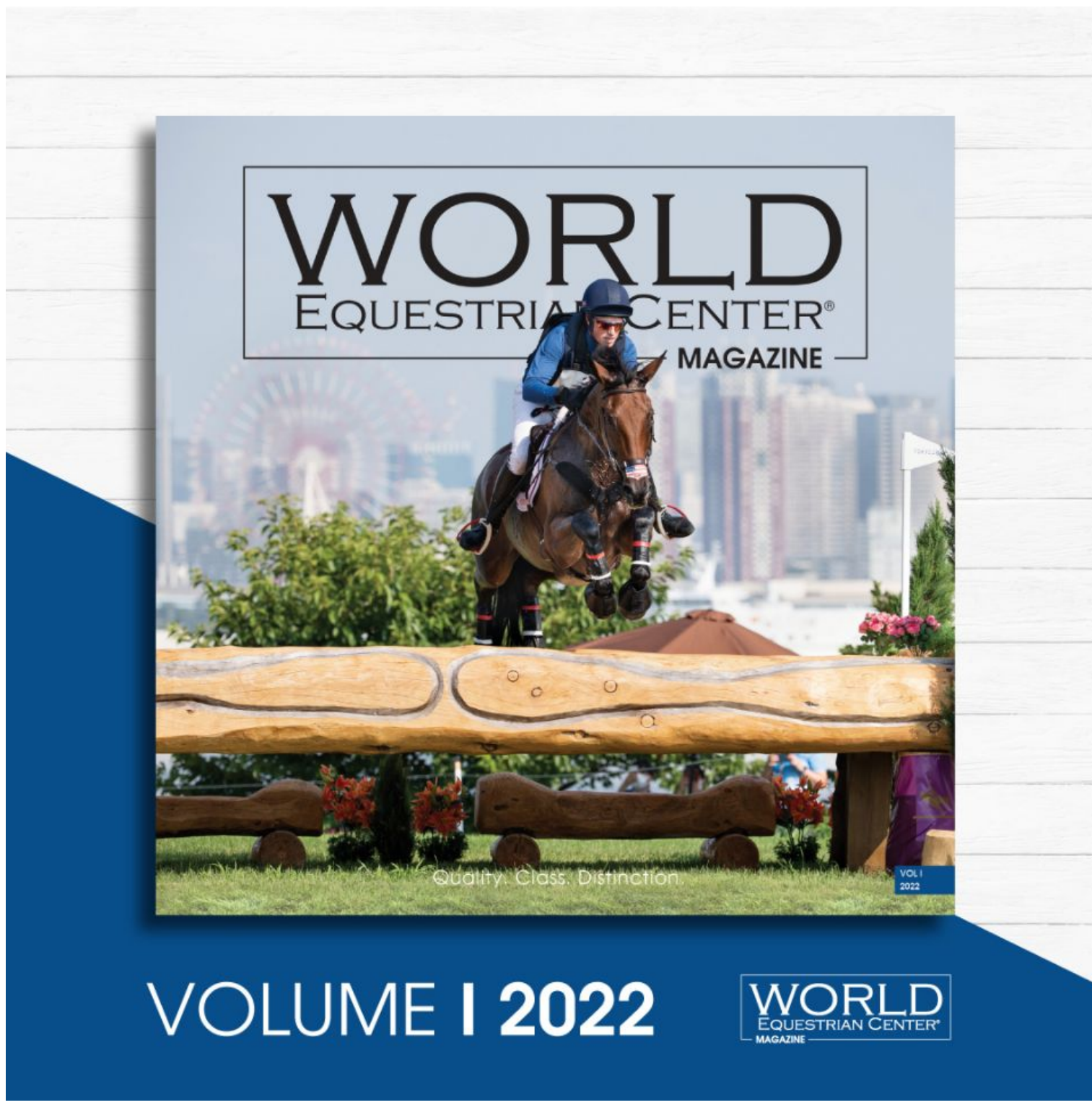

Chef's Corner: Vincent Cani



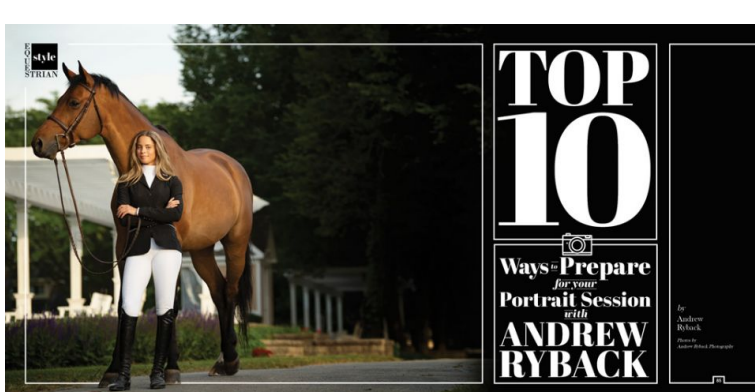
