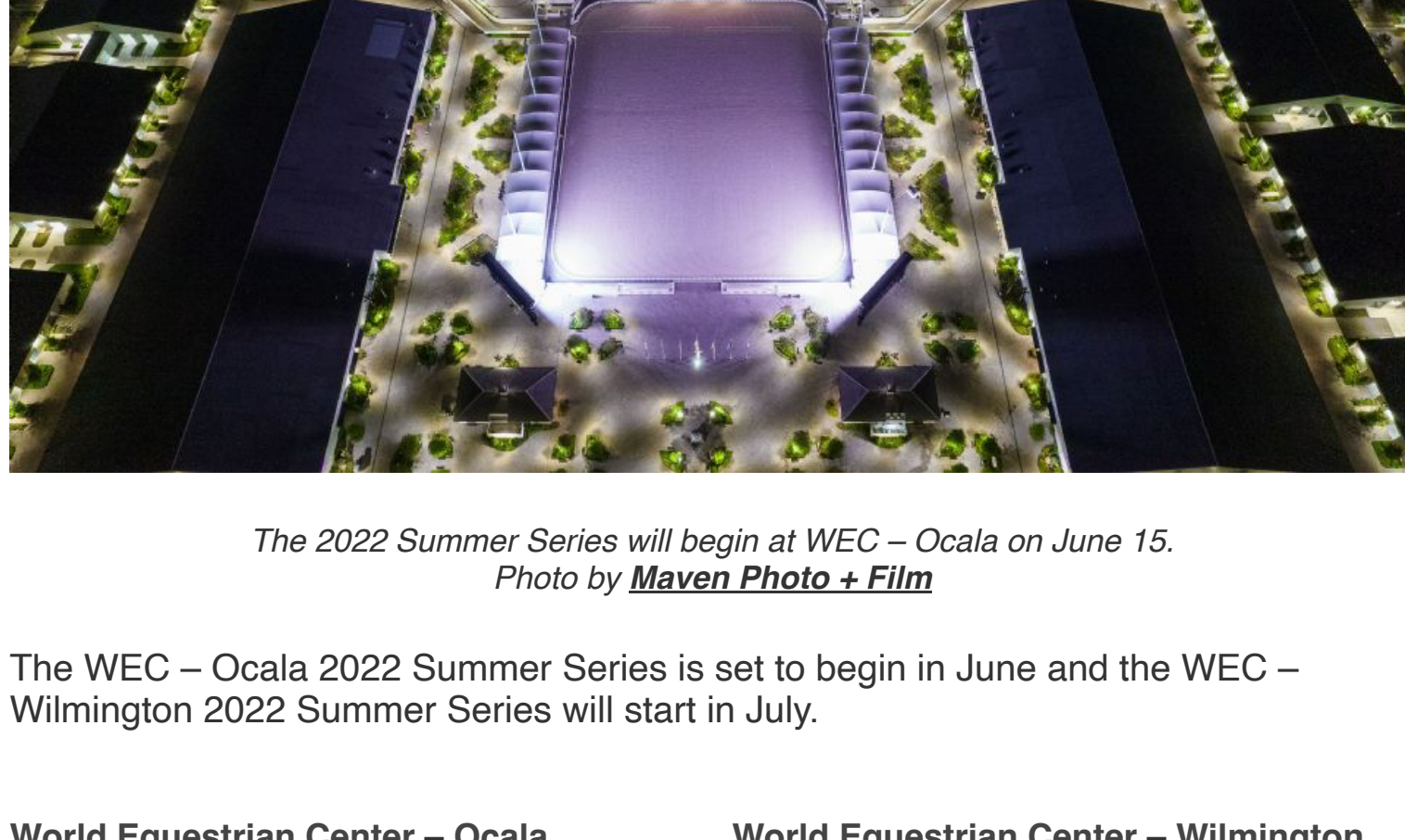

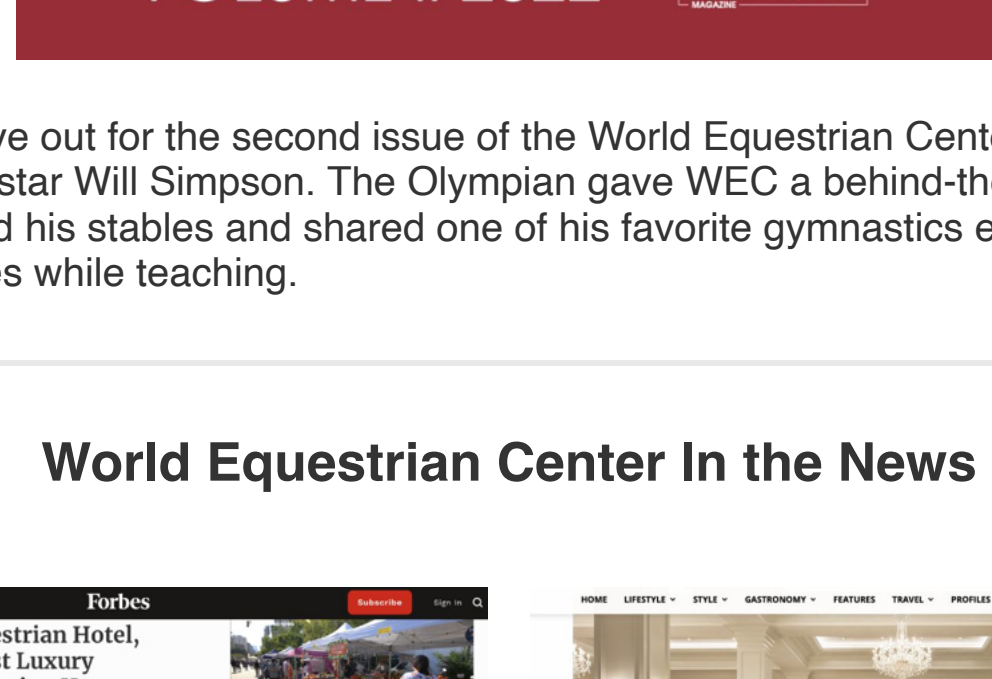

Kings Island in Mason, OH, is the largest amusement and waterpark in the Midwest and only a short drive away from WEC – Wilmington. The park is open early spring through fall and reopens for Winterfest during the holiday season. Guests can enjoy over 100 different rides and attractions including 15 rollercoasters and 36 water slides.

Another exciting activity to enjoy near Wilmington, OH, is the Ozone Zipline Adventure. The facility has several different courses with beautiful views and varying levels of difficulty. The Cowan Lake State Park is located close to WEC – Wilmington as well and offers swimming, fishing, sailing and kayaking.
