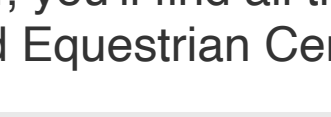

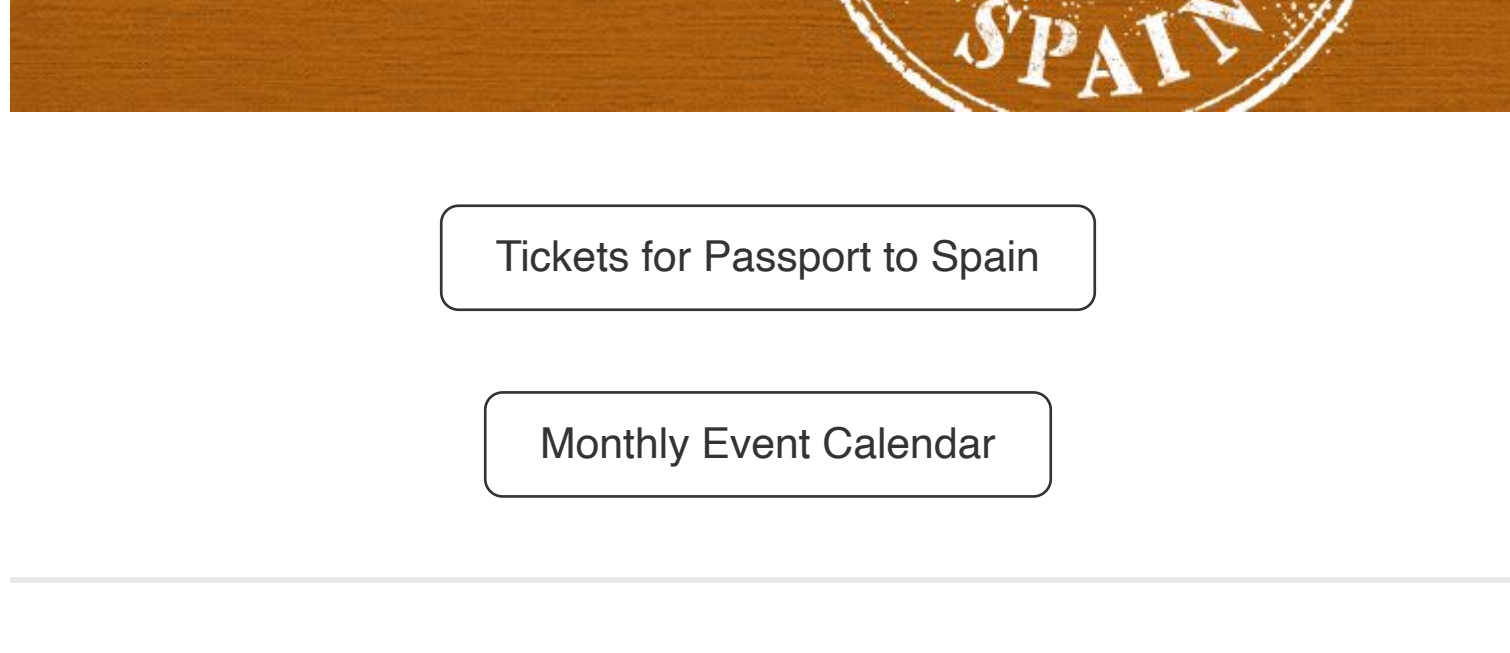
World Equestrian Center – Ocala:

Citrus County Kennel Club All-Breed Dog Show: July 8-10

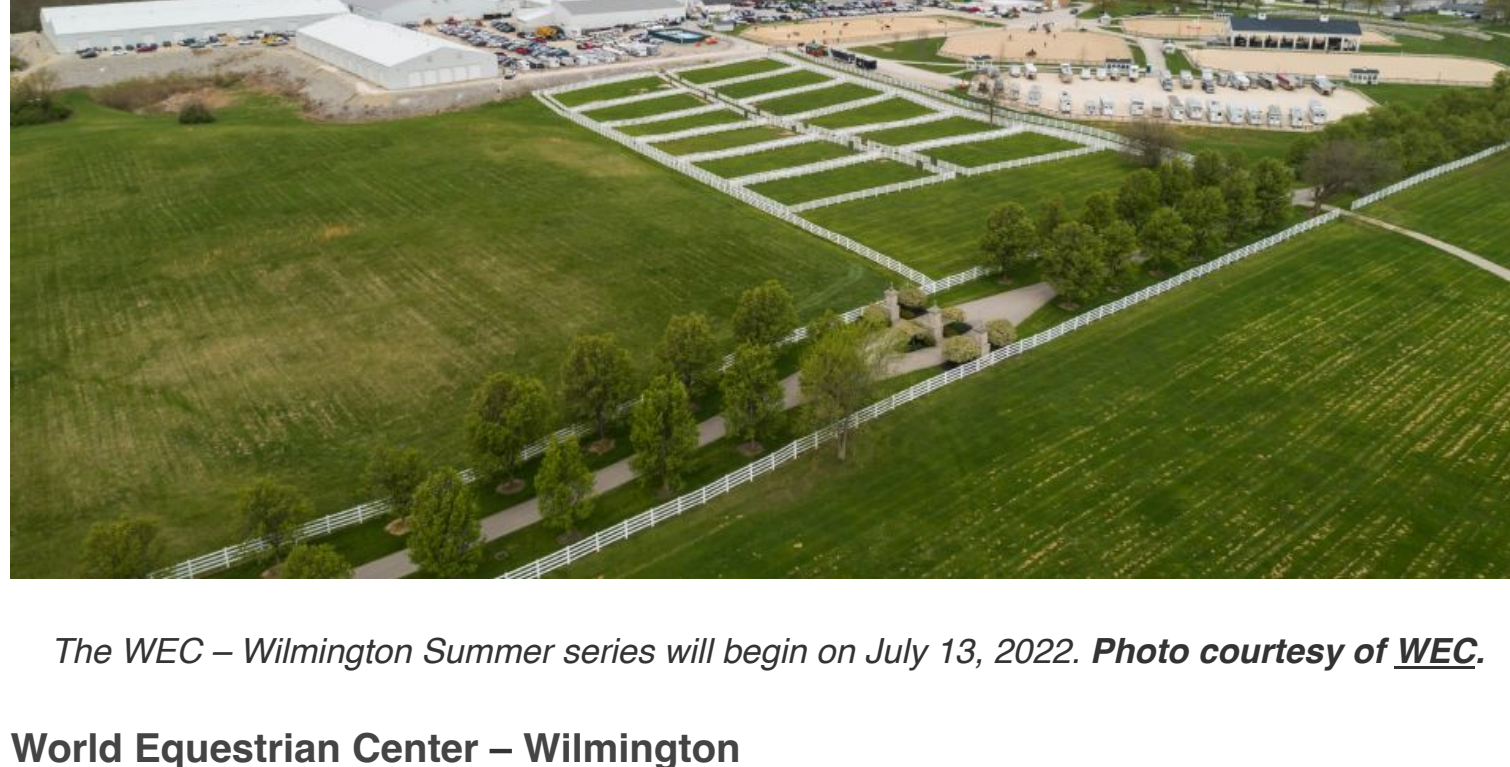

The Clinton County Humane Society is staffed by volunteers who are committed to helping animals find homes and receive proper veterinary care. In 2021, the organization helped 337 animals find safe homes.

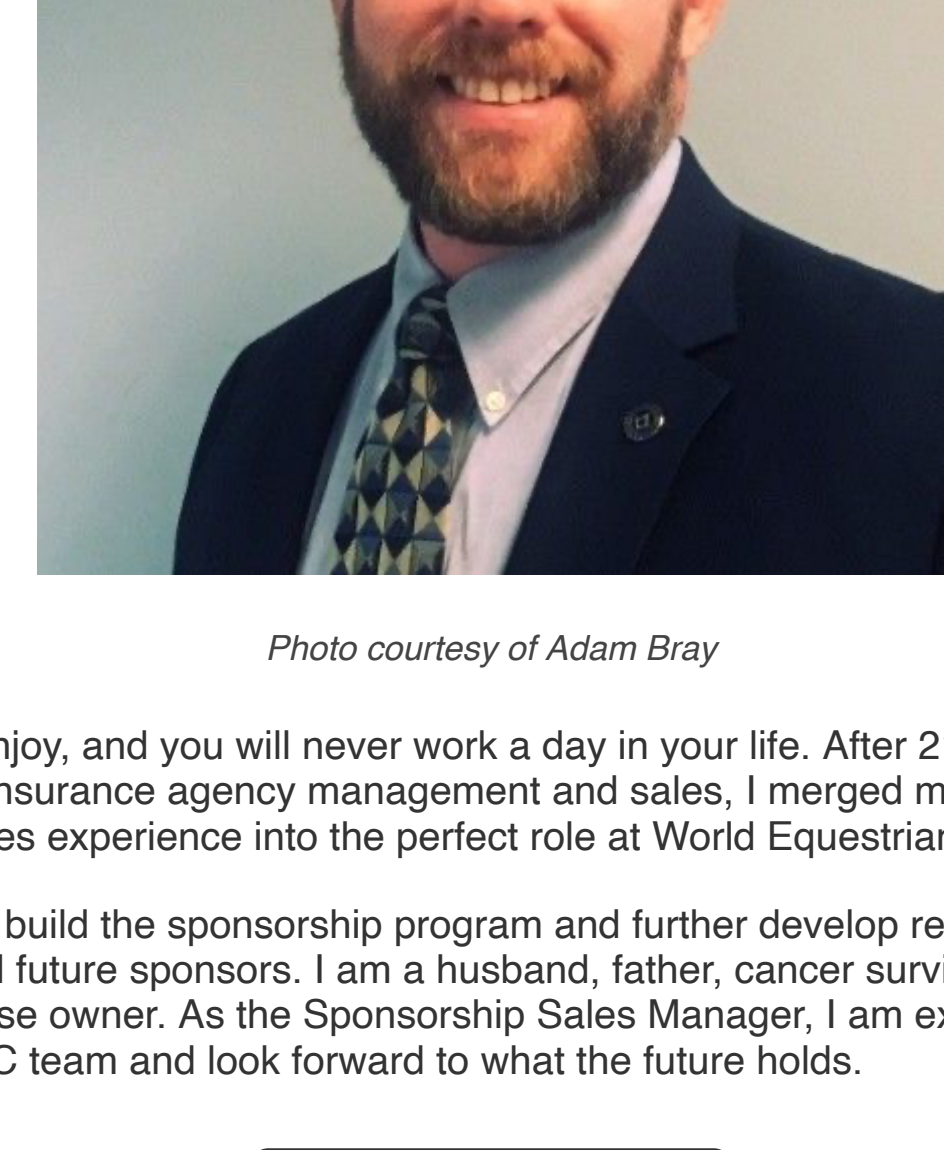


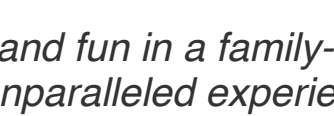
