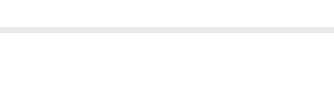
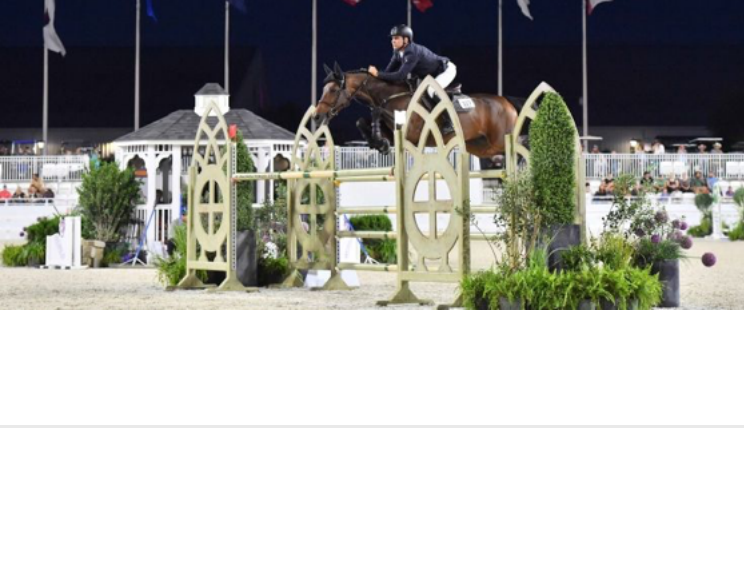

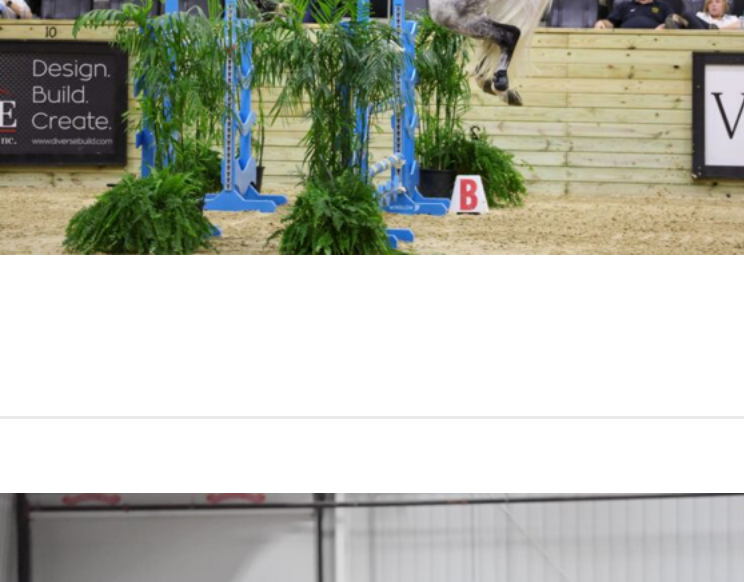
## World Equestrian Center Highlights From Ocala Summer VI and Wilmington Summer I

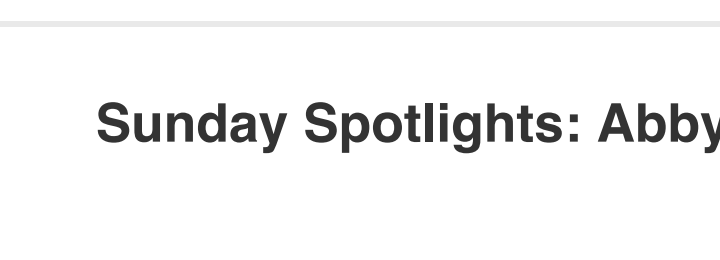

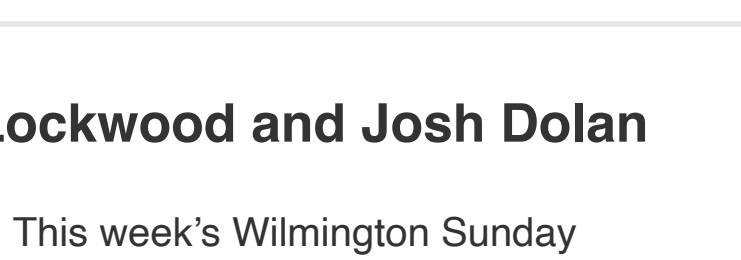
