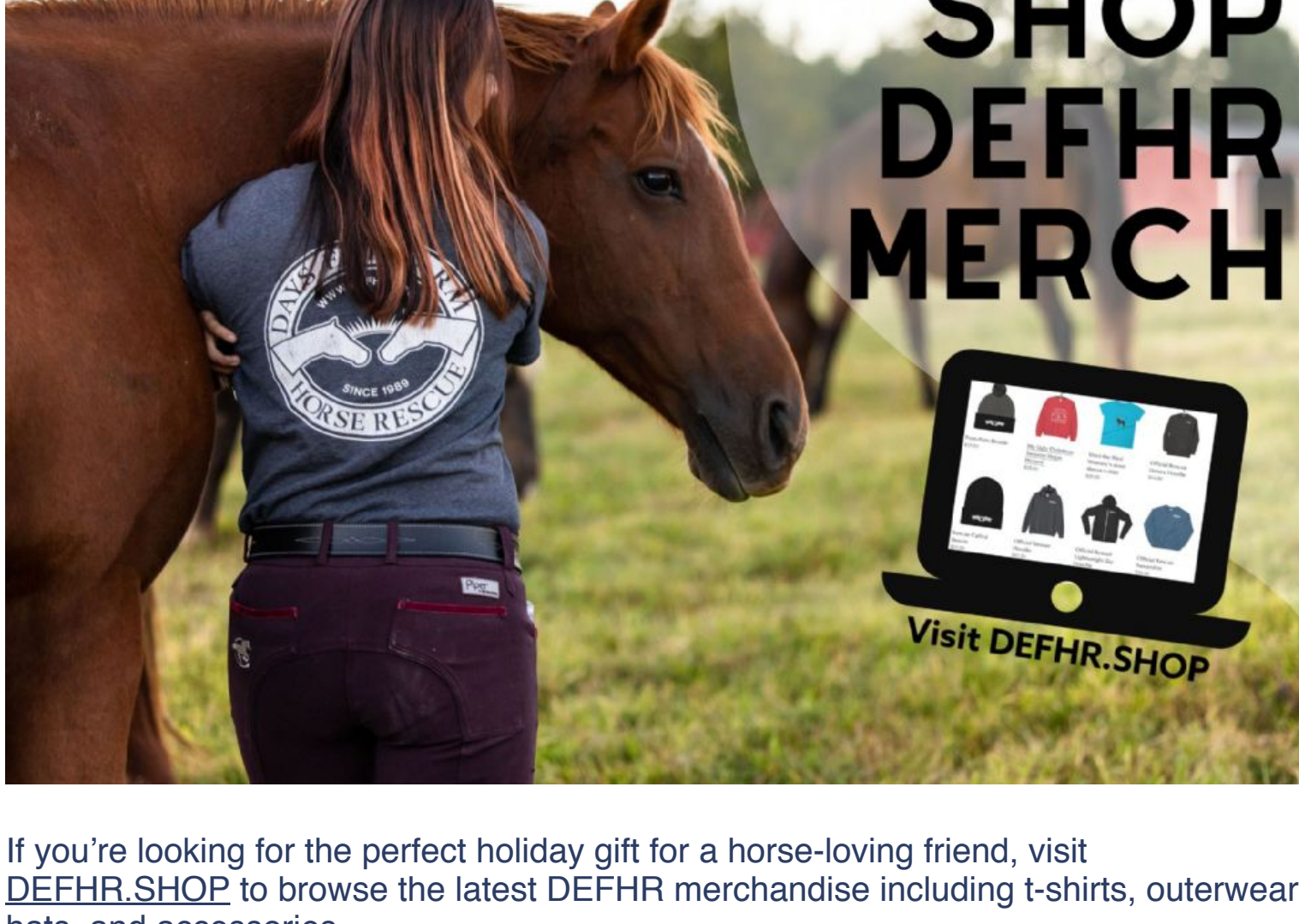

## Join DEFHR's Equidopt Grooming Program

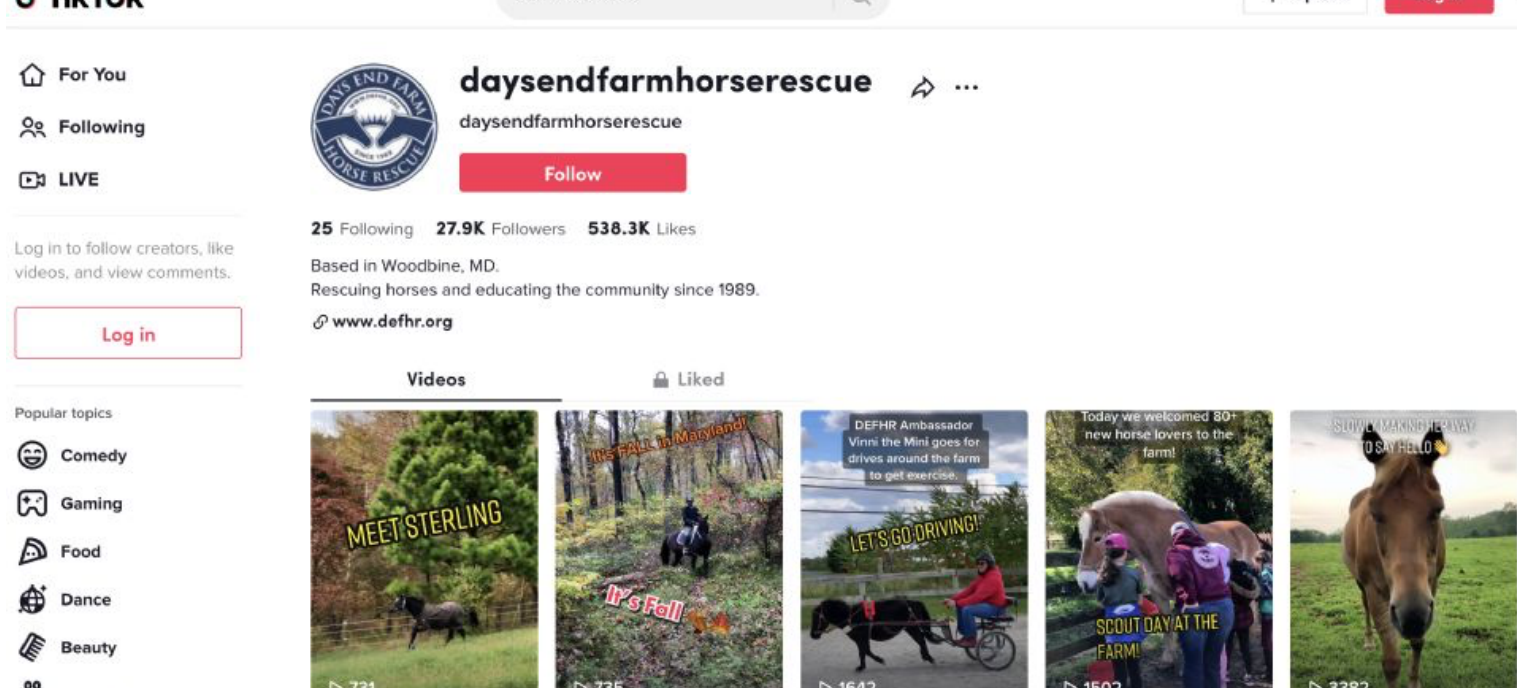
