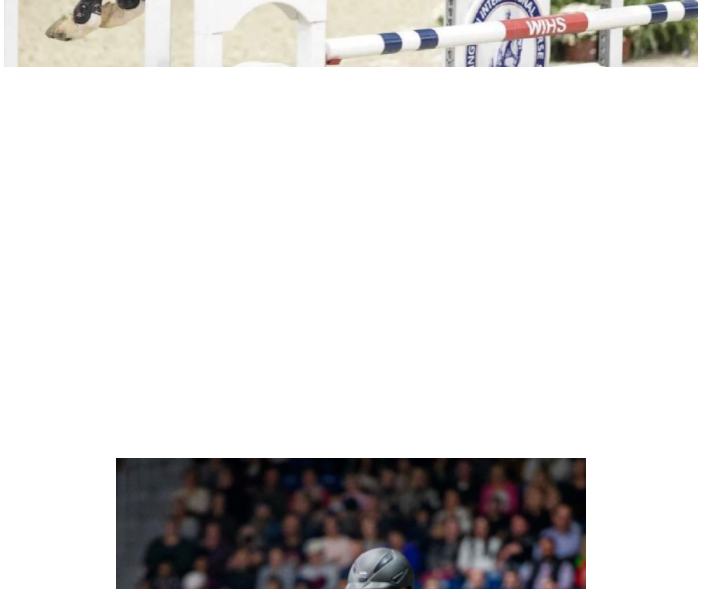

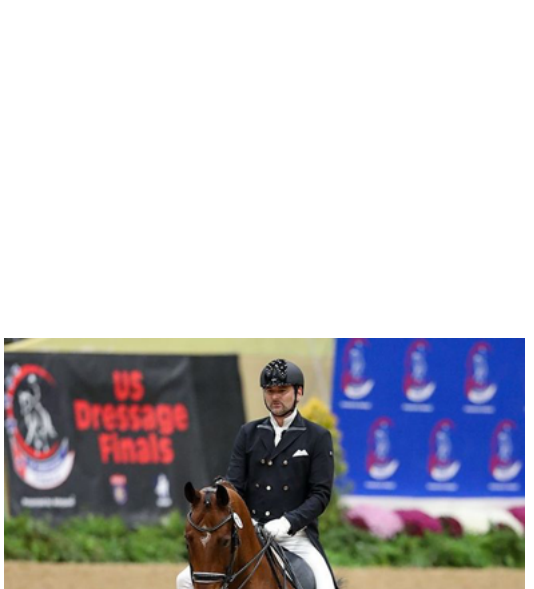


Daniel Coyle Wins World Cup at The Royal
