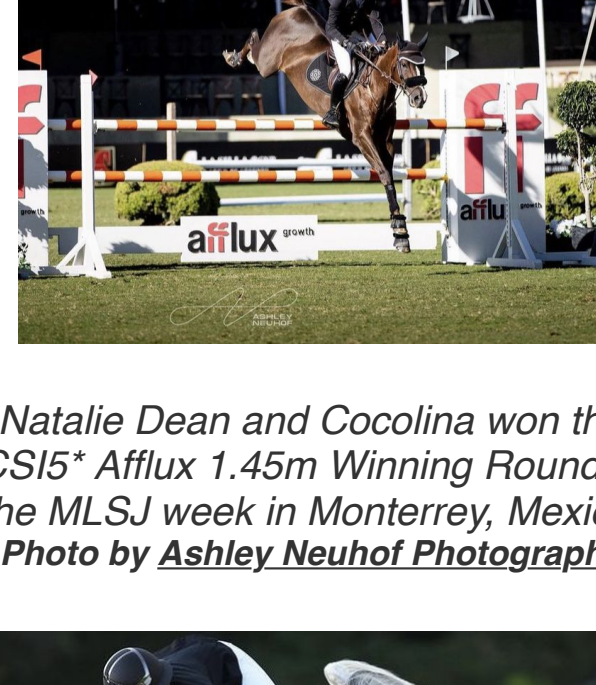

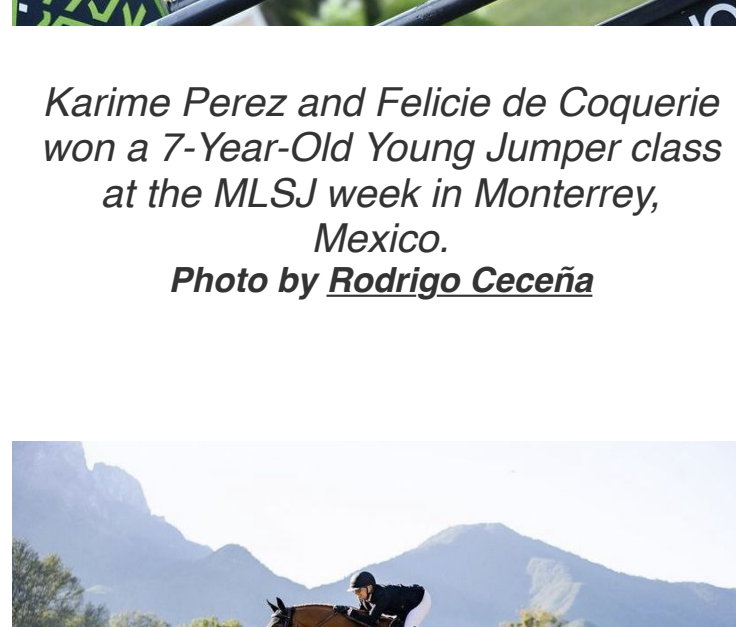

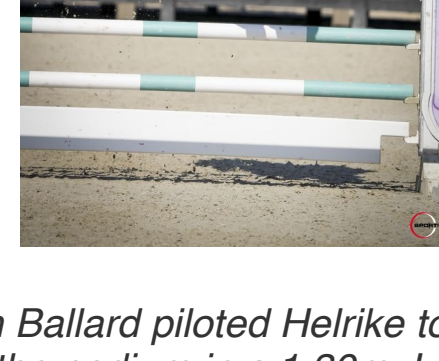

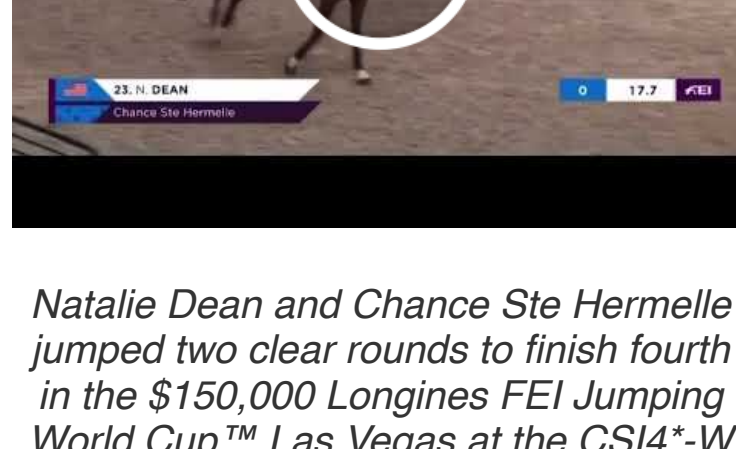

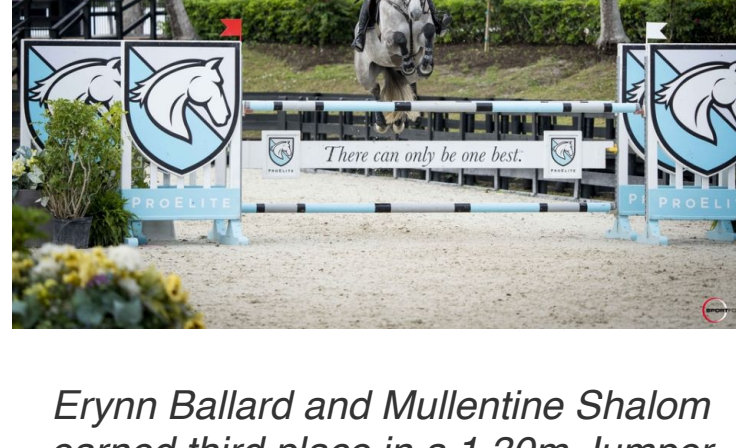

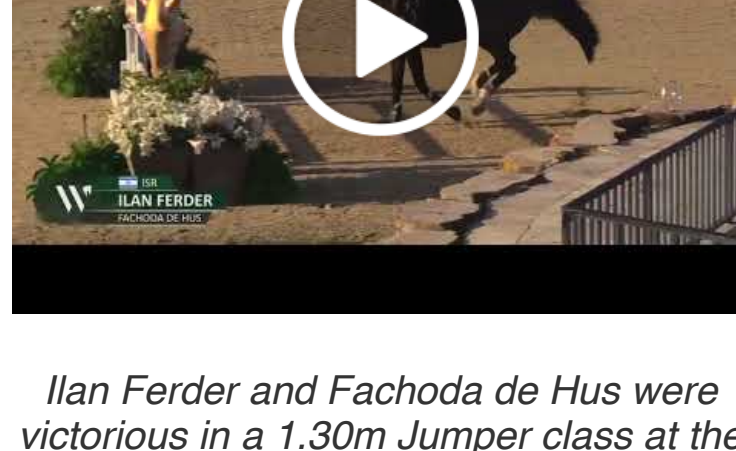

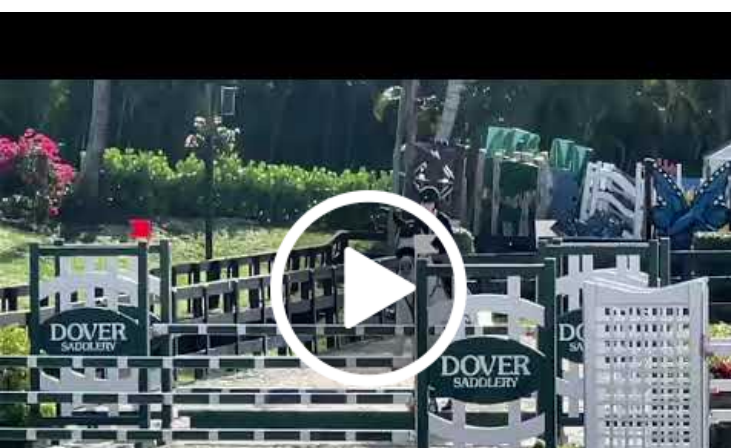

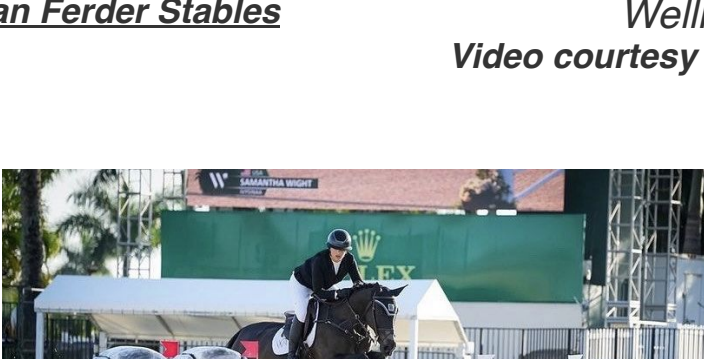

Meet Chance Ste Hermelle, owned and ridden by Natalie Dean

What is your favorite treat?
I love sugar cubes! I am a little funny when people try to get on me so I get one from my groom, Miguel, to help me stand quietly.

Where is your favorite place to show?
My favorite place to show is the Las Vegas National Horse Show. I have shown there for the last two years and I really like the atmosphere. The small indoor arena helps keep me calmer than at other horse shows.

Would you rather show indoors or outdoors?
Definitely indoors! I stay much more relaxed in indoor arenas.

What do you enjoy most about showing?

A Day in the Life With: Erynn Ballard



Canadian show jumping athlete Erynn Ballard has spent more time on the road than usual in 2022. After starting her season at home in Wellington, FL, where she works for Ilán Ferder Stables, the Ontario native found herself swept up in an exciting year for the Canadian program, as Olympic gold medalist Eric Lamaze retired from the saddle to steer the team toward the Agria FEI Jumping World Championship in Herning, Denmark. Ballard spent the summer showing across Europe and North America with the Canadian squad, ultimately earning a spot on Canada's all-female world championship team with one-time sales horse Gakhir, an 11-year-old Dutch Warmblood stallion (Spartacus TN—Zahkira, Labor's VDL Indorado) owned by Ferder and Esperanza Imports LLC.

Three months later, the 41-year-old is still traveling, following the Major League Show Jumping Tour as it winds from Canada down through the United States to a three-show stop in Mexico and beyond. Ballard takes us through a day in her life on the road from the Club Hípico La Silla CSI5* and CSI2* in Monterrey, Mexico.
