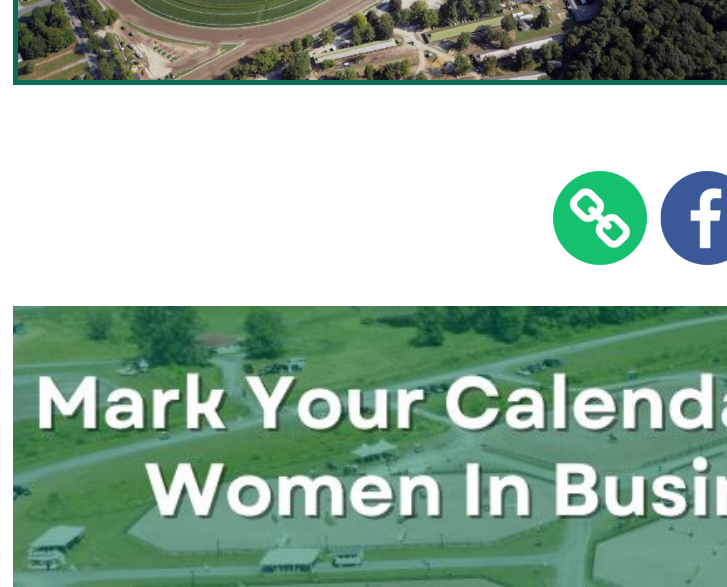
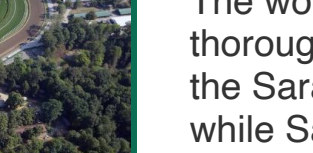
Local Area Highlights

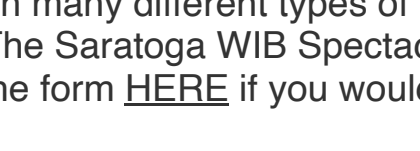
Daleys Adventure Boat Tours

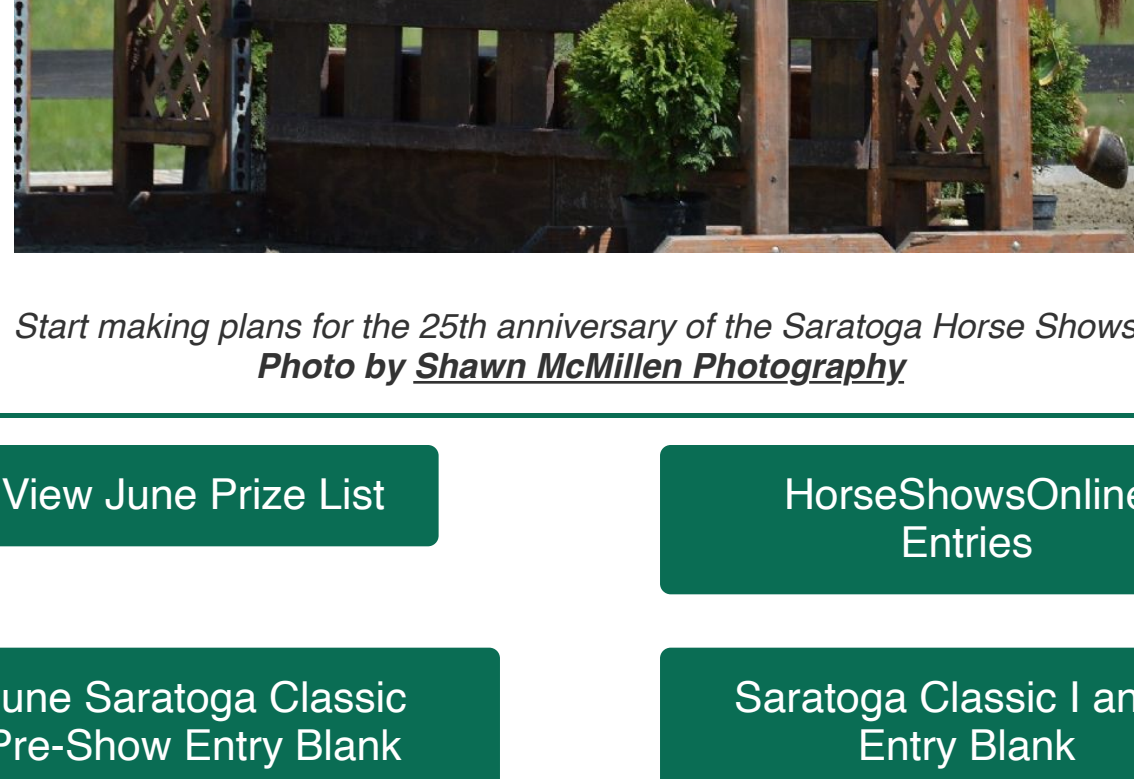
