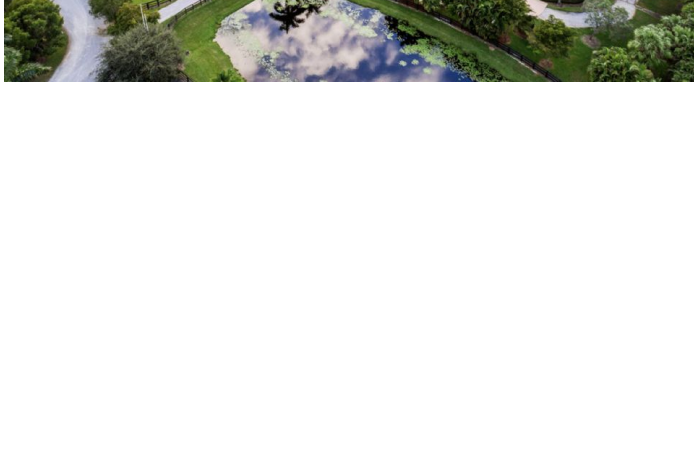

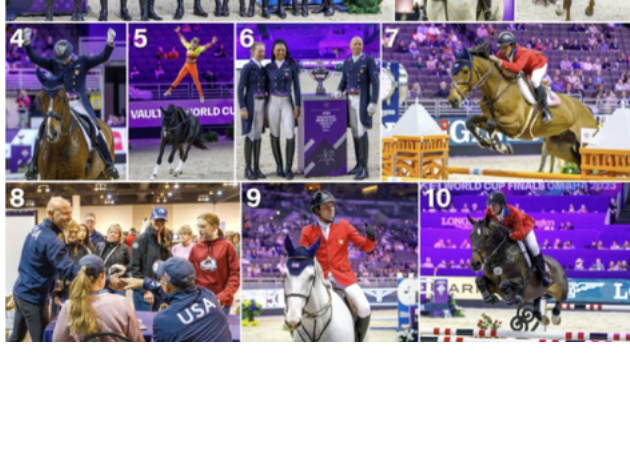


To Treat or Not To Treat

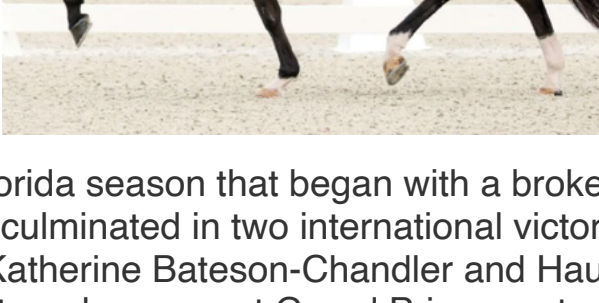

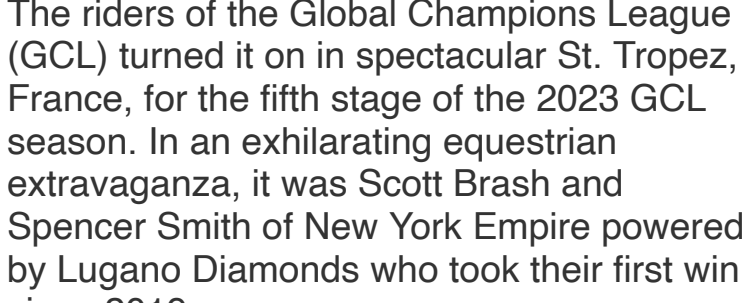

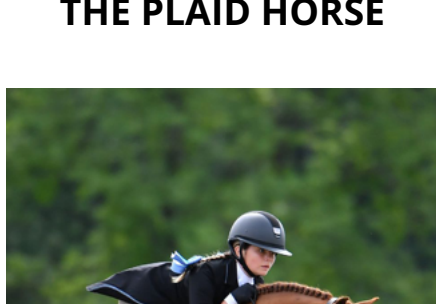

Rio the Reliable Rescue

What started as a routine welfare check by animal control officers in Washington County, MD, in August 2015, quickly turned into a terrible scene.

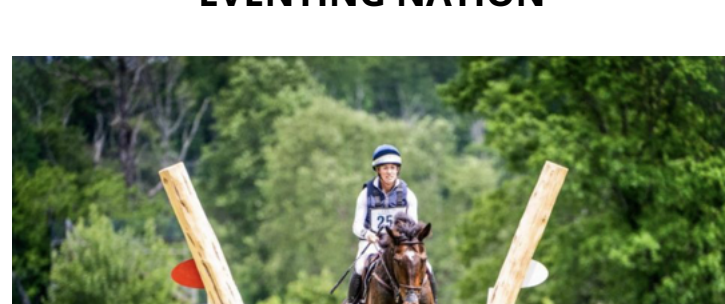
Officers discovered three horses in horrific condition inside of a small, old barn on the property. They later learned the horses had been suffering from extreme neglect for more than 10 years. One of them, an 18-year-old miniature horse stallion, now called Rio, was emaciated and had severely overgrown hooves, a fractured jaw, and an old hip injury that made walking painful.

Fortunately, his life was about to change. When the horses were seized, they were brought to Days End Farm Horse Rescue (DEFHR) in Woodbine, MD, for rehabilitation, training, and eventual adoption.

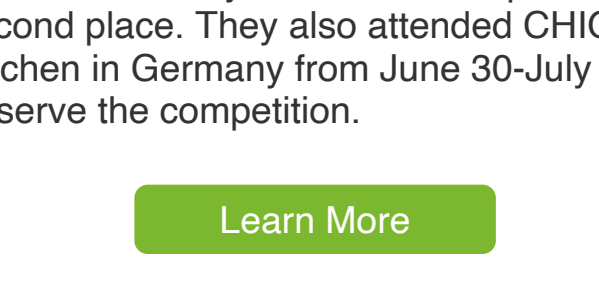
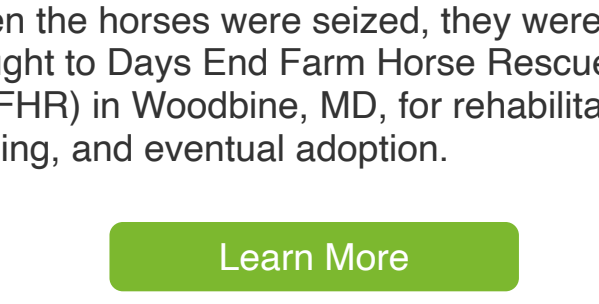


The United States Equestrian Team (USET) Foundation announced the newest recipients of the Karen E. Stives Endowment Fund Grant. The grant, in partnership with additional funding from US Equestrian (USEF), enabled four up-and-coming U.S. eventing combinations to participate in the U.S. Equestrian European Development Tour for the summer of 2023.

As part of the tour, the athletes and horses competed in the FEI Eventing Nations Cup™ Poland CCI04*-NC-S at the Strzegom Horse Trials in Poland from June 21-25 where they finished on the podium in second place. They also attended CHIO Aachen in Germany from June 30-July 1 to observe the competition.
