honors in the \$50,000 Florida Coast Equipment National Grand Prix. "He's a very nice horse. He is very competitive, very fast and wants to do


the job. I've been riding him for a year and a half now, and he's been incredible. Next week he will jump the three-star." Photo by Andrew Ryback Photography






