



What is your history with CCHS? As a junior rider, I didn't really do a lot of indoor shows; that started more with the adult amateurs. I've been a pretty consistent competitor at Capital Challenge for the

past 15-plus years. Being at Capital Challenge is a really different schedule than what we are used to. It's a whole different thing getting up and riding early — you typically have to get in

the ring at 6 a.m. — but it's the culmination of the year for us. Riders from the West Coast come for the year-end competition. It's the best horses and riders who typically show up, so it's extremely competitive.



They make a really special effort. If you win you get a medal, a moment of celebration, and a bit of a tip of the hat, which makes it more special than regular

weekend shows. They make a little extra fuss if you're fortunate enough to win, which is lovely.

What is it like to win at CCHS? To win at a venue like Capital Challenge is very satisfying. There is a lot of hard work that goes into preparing the horses, and we have a whole team who does that.
