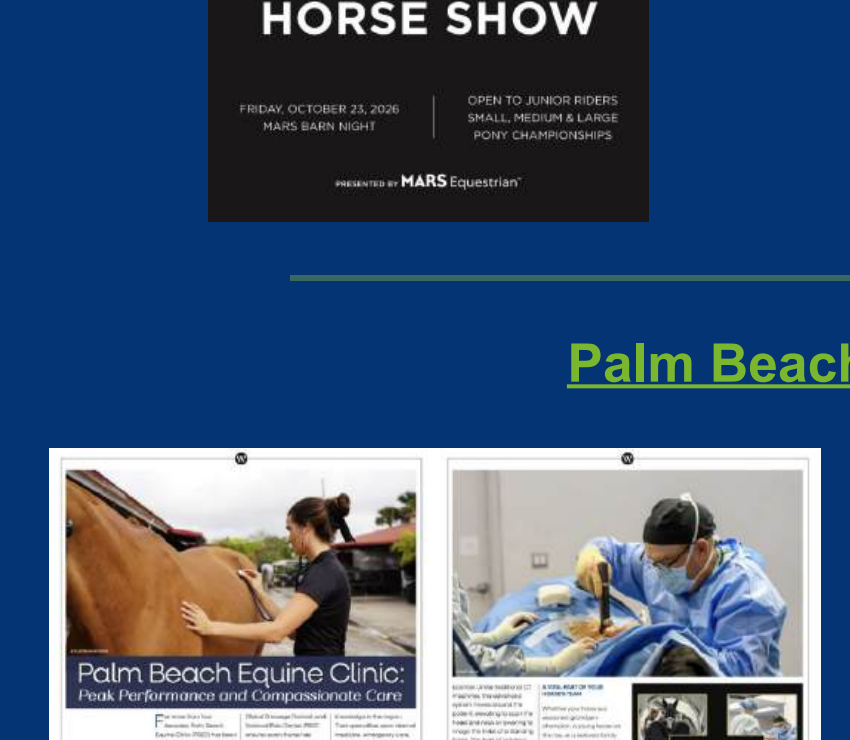
West Coast USET Foundation Gala Raises \$485,000

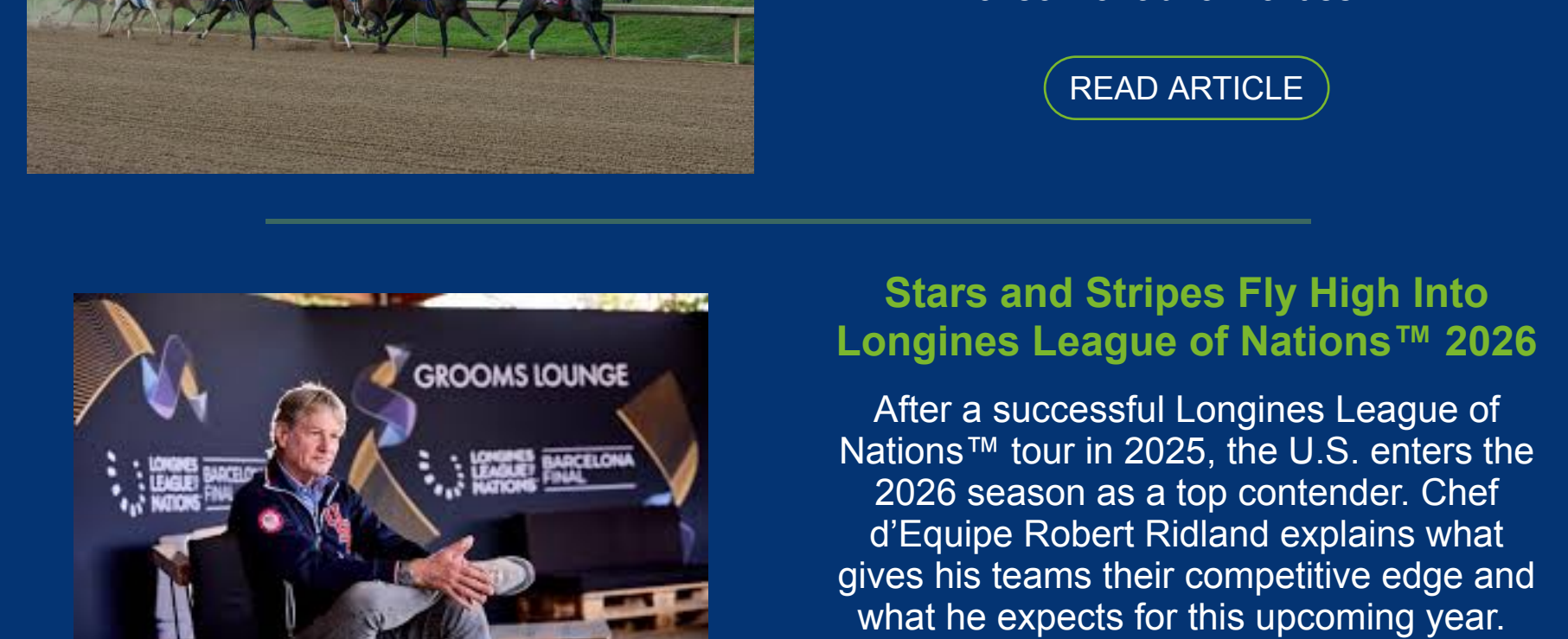

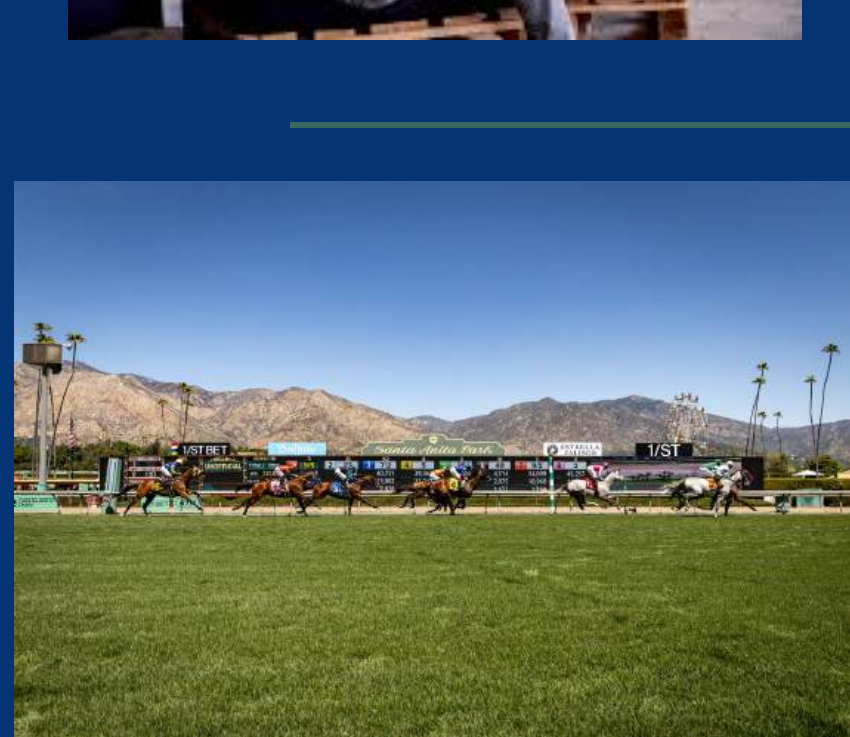

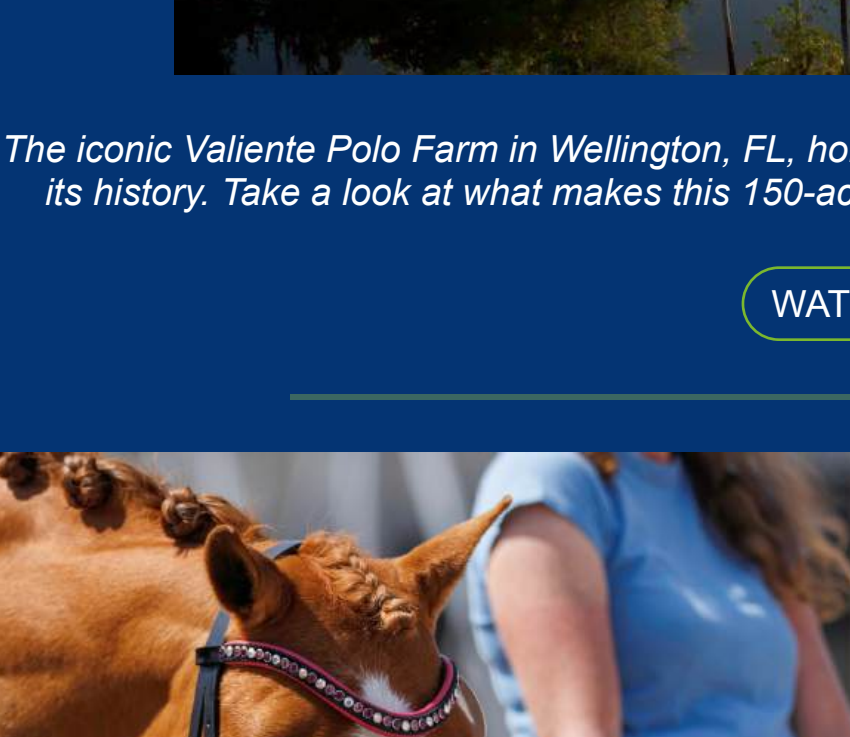
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Boyd Martin: 2025 World Equestrian Brands USEA Rider of the Year

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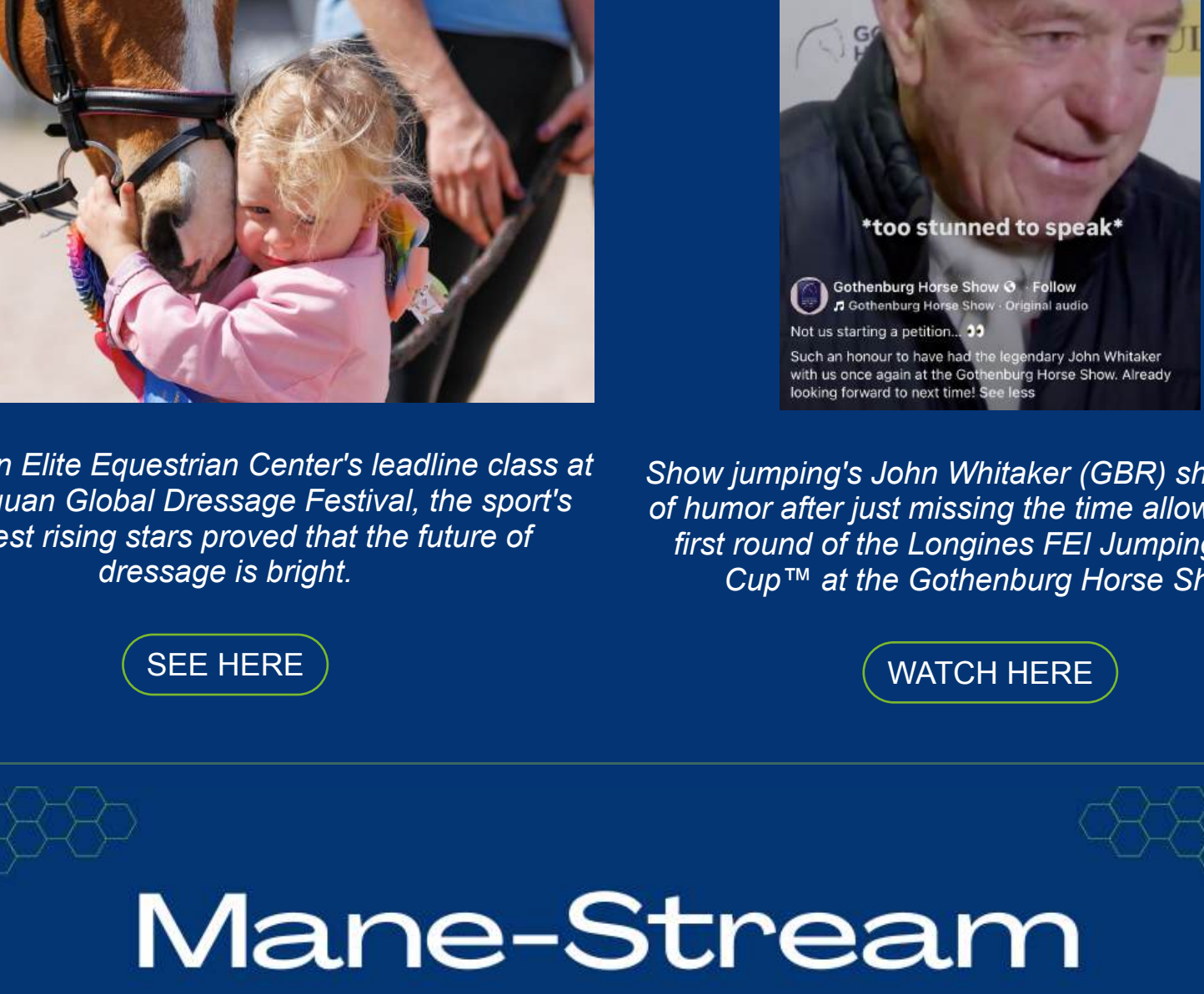


'Everyone Welcome' Initiative Proved Successful in Aberdeen

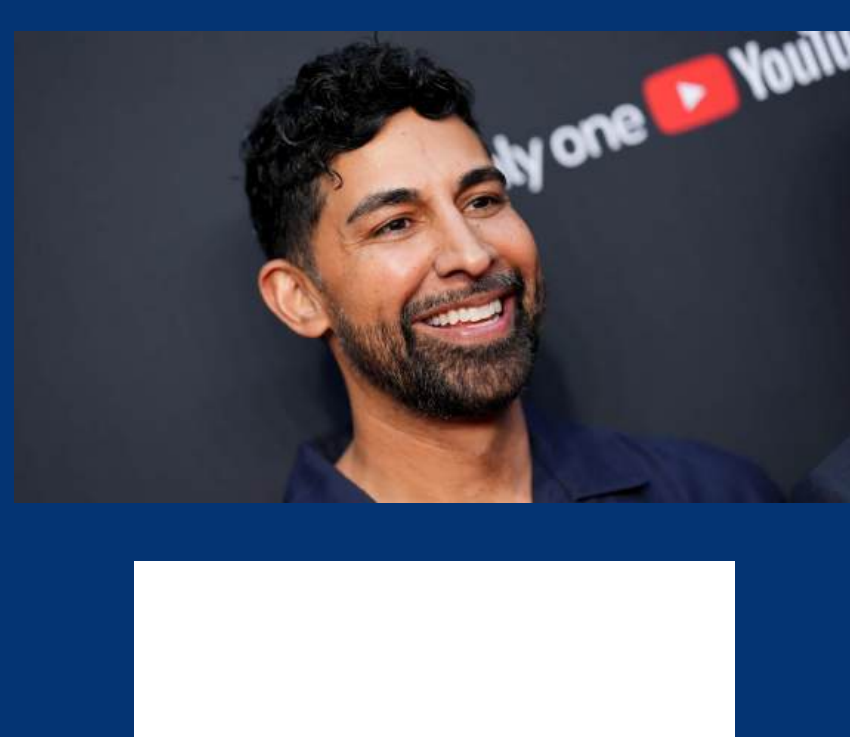
